For more than 20 years, he has been forging Wilhelm.tel to one of the most innovative regional telecommunication companies in Germany. He has a strong focus on combining fibre networks (FttB/H) with wireless connectivity applications and has been promoting 5G as “broadcasted fibre”.

Wolfgang Heer is CEO of German fibre access association BUGLAS since 2011. BUGLAS as the only German telco association exclusively focused on FttB/H is constantly shaping a “fibre-fit” framework for the biggest European economy. Its number of members has meanwhile risen to 120, mostly municipal utilities, communal enterprises and institutions.
